

Financially Supported Level 3 Youth Worker training still available starting May 2024

The East of England and East Midlands Regional Youth Work Unit has a few remaining financially supported places available for the **Level 3 Certificate**

The course is available across the region and will be delivered on-line.

Learners will need to produce a portfolio of evidence for each unit which will need to be completed shortly after the end of the course. Learners will spend typically 15 hours per month study time.

To start the Level 3 Certificate, you must have completed the Level 2 Youth Work Award previously. If you do not have this, please apply for the Level 2 award with courses starting in May and September. There will be a second Level 3 course in September.

To be eligible for the Level 3 places you need to be currently delivering Youth Work in either a voluntary or paid capacity, be working with groups or if working with individuals be able to create groupwork projects and be undertaking a minimum of 3 hours work per week with young people. Level 3 candidates need to be supported by a workplace supervisor who can observe practice from time to time.

Places will be allocated on a first come basis by region and who meet the above criteria.
